The organization consists of the major Danish suppliers to the Royal Danish Navy as well as foreign companies joining as affiliated members, and several products have been developed in co-operation with the navy. The Royal Danish Navy holds a reputation for demanding and succeeding in getting advanced products of the highest quality at prices matching very tight budgets. As a result, Naval Team Denmark's members can offer export customers products and know-how of the highest

international standard at extremely competitive prices.

Besides, Naval Team Denmark's collaboration with the Royal Danish Navy means that demonstrations of ships and onboard equipment can be arranged and customers can be offered adequate training programmes and logistic support schemes. Naval Team Denmark was established in 1992 as a result of the worldwide interest attracted by the development of the unique Danish Standard Flex concept. Application of the concept offers financial flexibility as modules can be developed and acquired in accordance with economic feasibility. The concept allows

maintenance and upgrading without taking ships out of service, and it provides multi-role capability as outfit of modules for various roles can quickly be exchanged. Thus fewer ships than with a fleet of different single-role vessels can meet operational requirements.

14 units of the Standard Flex 300 multi-role (FLYVEFISKEN class) were commissioned in the period 1989 – 1996, and in 1991 – 1992 four units of the Standard Flex 3000 Offshore

Patrol Ships (THETIS class) came into service. Two 6.600 tonnes Combat Support Ships (ABSALON class) have recently been delivered and have already proved their capability in international operations.

In addition the Royal Danish Navy has taken delivery of two 2.000 tonnes Offshore Patrol Vessels (KNUD RASMUSSEN class), six 200 tonnes Patrol Vessels (DIANA class) and 6 minor vessels (HOLM class).

Finally three 6.000 tonnes multi role frigates (IVER HUITFELDT class) will be delivered in 2011. All these ships and vessels benefit from the advantages of the modular concept and all are offered for potential export.

However, it should also be born in mind that the members of Naval Team Denmark successfully offer their individual products for export.
